<b>15 - The Throw In</b>	One rethrow after explanation from referee shall be given.			
<b>16 – The Goal Kick</b>	Conforms to FIFA with the following exceptions:  a) The opposing team MUST retreat to their own half of the field. b) The kicker MUST WAIT until this happens. c) The opposing team CAN ATTACK AS SOON AS THE BALL IS KICKED AND MOVES. d) If the ball does not leave the penalty area, the goal kick should be retaken. e) The ball must touch the ground or another player before crossing the halfway line <i>For ANY violation of the above, the goal kick MUST BE RETAKEN.</i>	Conforms to FIFA with the following exceptions:  a) The opposing team MUST retreat to their own half of the field. b) The kicker MUST WAIT until this happens. c) The opposing team CAN ATTACK AS SOON AS THE BALL IS KICKED AND MOVES. d) The ball must touch the ground or another player before crossing the halfway line <i>For ANY violation of the above, the goal kick MUST BE RETAKEN.</i>

OTHER		<p><b>KEEPER POSSESSION:</b>          If the goalkeeper gains possession of the ball with his or her hands:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) The opposing team <b>MUST</b> retreat to their own half of the field.</li> <li>b) The keeper <b>MUST WAIT</b> until this happens.</li> <li>c) The keeper <b>MUST DISTRIBUTE THE BALL</b> with his or her hands.</li> <li>d) The opposing team <b>CAN ATTACK AS SOON AS THE BALL LEAVES THE KEEPER'S HANDS.</b></li> <li>e) The ball must touch the ground or another player before crossing the halfway line</li> </ul> <p><i>For ANY violation of the above, the keeper possession <b>MUST BE REPEATED</b>.
